Filing Deadline: MCL 168.193(1)	Filings must be made by <b>4:00 p.m., on April 24, 2024</b> (15 <sup>th</sup> Tuesday before Primary Election)

Withdrawal: MCL 168.194	Candidates wishing to withdraw must submit in writing no later than <b>4:00 p.m., April 26, 2024</b>
Oath & Bond: MCL 168.204	Oath is filed with County Clerk Bond is filed with Treasurer; *Prosecuting Attorney does not file bond; *Treasurer files bond with the County Clerk

Campaign Finance:	<p>All candidates are required to file a Campaign Finance Statement of Organization with the County Clerk within 20 days of becoming a candidate. It is the candidate's responsibility to contact the Clerk's office at (231) 922-4760 to determine what the reporting requirements may be. This is to be done prior to expending funds, advertising, or placing signs in support of your campaign, to avoid improper activities.</p> <p>Incumbent Candidates are on file and can amend committee.</p>
