

# POWER/BASSETT ISLAND CAMPING

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION



### Check-In/Out & Site Information

- Check-in begins at 3:00 PM; Check out is 12:00 PM
- Site capacity is six individuals aged 10 or older. Children < 10 are not included in the six person limit but no more than four children under the age of 10 are permitted on each campsite. Children < 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and cannot be left unattended.
- No more than two shelters per site are permitted.
- The individual renting a site must be present at Power/Bassett Island during the rental period.

### Quiet Wilderness Reserve: Do Your Part

Power Island's reputation as a "Quiet Wilderness Reserve" is yours to help maintain.

**Extinguish all fires-** do not leave fires unattended. It is okay to use downfall as firewood but do not cut down any standing wood.

**Keep pets on a leash** as required by law.

**Avoid excessive noise-** sound carries on the island!

**Pack out your trash.** Garbage trucks do not do pick-ups on the island.

**Only the 3 Ps in the toilets-** Poop, Pee, and Paper! Our vault toilets are manually pumped to an on-island septic system- anything other than waste and paper can cause irreparable damage.



### Know Before You Go

**Parking:** The closest launch to Power Island is the DNR Bowers Harbor ramp. It is recommended to call the DNR (231-922-5280) for parking information prior to leaving your vehicle overnight there. Elmwood Township Marina may offer paid overnight parking (231 946-5463).

**Weather/Rain Check Policy:** A "rain check" may be granted when there is a Small Craft Advisory/Warning or Gale Advisory/Warning for Grand Traverse Bay on the original date of the reservation. Contact Parks and Rec within three business days of the original reservation to reschedule, based on campsite availability.
